## **The Sacrament of Holy Communion**

We come to the Table of our Lord Jesus Christ, knowing that we have sinned and fallen short of the fullness of life that God intended for us. But through faith we hear Christ's invitation to share in the assurance written by the Apostle Paul to the church in Cornith: that anyone who is in Christ is a new creation; the old life is gone, and a new life is begun.

Lead: (Thanks for the work of Christ, ending with...) ...together we proclaim the mystery of faith.

**All: Christ has died.  
Christ has risen.  
Christ shall come again.**

Lead: (Thanksgiving for the work of the Spirit, ending with...) ...together the people of faith...

**All: AMEN!**

Lead: Through Christ, and in Christ.

Through the work of the Holy Spirit.

All glory to God:

Creator, Redeemer, and Sustainer. AMEN
