After the books of the Law, History, and Wisdom, the last quarter of what Christians call the Old Testament moves into a section we call the Prophets. A few of these books are significant in size and popularity. *Isaiah* has 25,608 words, *Jeremiah* has 33,002, (largest in the Bible) and *Ezekiel* has 29,918. Along with *Daniel* (only 9001 words) these are called the Major Prophets.

The Major Prophets are followed by the so-called Minor Prophets – called that not because they are unimportant, but because their messages are comparatively short. The Hebrew Bible groups these into one combined book called the *Book of the Twelve*.

Today's reading is from the book of *Haggai*, which has only 2 chapters. He was one of the last of the prophets, giving hope to the people of Judah who were very discouraged after return from exile.
